

Notification of Intent to Invite National Competitive Bids Plus (NCB+)

SOERREISA NORWAY – RESTORE ACCESS TUNNEL CABLE RAILWAY

1. Background

Norwegian Defence Estates Agency (NDEA) - on behalf of the Government of Norway - intends to issue an invitation to submit tender under the rules and procedures for National Competitive Bidding Plus (NCB+) as defined for the NATO Security Investment Programme. The project will cover the restoration of the access tunnel cable railway at a military site at Soerreisa. Soerreisa is located in Northern Norway approximately 150 km south of the city of Tromsøe.

With this notification document, NDEA would like to ensure that eligible firms from any NATO member nation are informed and invited to participate in the competition.

2. Scope

The project will restore the existing cable railway running in-rock from the valley station to the top of the nearby summit. The cable railway consists of a cable car, which is pulled on rails by a metal wire system supported by a winch. The contract to be established will include the following:

- Restoration of the rail system, total railway length is approximately 1 100 m.
- Restoration of the railway concrete base including arrangement for fitting the rails to the base

The total contract value of the contract is estimated at 3 000 000 Euro exclusive of VAT.

The project has been prefinanced in accordance with NATO rules and procedures.

3. Security.

All contractor personnel, which will require access to the site, must have a valid NATO Security clearance of NATO RESTRICTED.

The bid document to be issued to interested firms will be written in the Norwegian language.

4. Time scheduling

Interested firms desiring to participate in the bidding are requested to show interest via the TED system no later than 11 June 2018. TED - Tenders Electronics Daily (TED) (ted.europa.eu).

The existing concrete foundations with casted fixings shall be re-used to the greatest possible degree. If the fixing fails when the track is disassembled, or it is concluded that the fixing must be strengthened, this shall be carried out via a renovation or strengthening of the existing foundations.
